## THE STUDENT AMBASSADOR SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Student Ambassador Scholarship Program is designed to award high-achieving, current MTC students with scholarships of up to \$1,000 (up to, but not exceeding, the student's cost of attendance). In return, those students selected will serve approximately 50 hours per semester as a Student Ambassador of MTC. In this role they will assist the Office of Enrollment Services by: providing campus tours to prospective students and their families; calling prospective students; assist with a social media presence for MTC; recruitment event preparation and attendance; Marion Campus event help; representing MTC at occasional off-campus events such as community parades and career fairs; organizing and participating in a Student Ambassador charity drive. In conjunction with the financial assistance this program provides, it will also develop students' leadership and professional skills by facilitating their active engagement with campus events and activities.

To apply for this scholarship program, applicants must meet the minimum requirements listed below:

### *Minimum Requirements*

- 3.0+ cumulative GPA at the time of submitting Ambassador application
- Be enrolled for at least 6 credits per semester throughout the year
- Letter of recommendation from MTC faculty or staff member
- 2022-2023 FAFSA on file with the Financial Aid Office
- Must have a positive attitude about MTC
- Commit to Friday mornings/early afternoons for admission events
- Experienced with social media applications such as Facebook, Instagram, Twitter
- Willingness to interact with the general public in promotion of MTC
- Willingness to work in teams for event planning and promotion
