2026-2027 Parent FAFSA Refusal

Federal regulations give schools the authority to allow a student to borrow a Direct Unsubsidized Loan when the student's parents have ended all financial support and they refuse to complete and sign a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

This form does not allow a student to apply for financial aid as an Independent financial aid applicant. The completion of this form will only allow the student to request and borrow a Direct Unsubsidized Loan up to the annual and aggregate loan limit of a Dependent student. The student must be enrolled at least half-time status and be meeting MTC's Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) standards. No other federal or state need-based aid will be available to the student.

*If your parent refuses to sign and complete this form, you must get documentation from a third party, such as a teacher, counselor, court, etc.
